From the desk of Fr. Paul:

Dear Parishioners,

To begin the Jubilee Year of 2025, Pope Francis opened the Holy Door in the Vatican, which invites the graces and blessings of Christ in our pilgrimage journey. The last Jubilee Year was in 2016 when Pope Francis called for a Year of Mercy. This was an Extraordinary Jubilee because it was added in addition to the regular Jubilee years which take place every 25 years. Pope Francis has inaugurated this year to be the Jubilee Year of Hope. He opened the Holy Door of St. Peter's Basilica at the opening of the Midnight Christmas Mass. The Holy Door symbolizes the parable where Jesus says "I am the gate. Whoever enters through me will be saved and

will come in and go out and find pasture." - John 10:9

As the Holy Doors are opening in Rome, the irony doesn't escape me that we will be closing the doors to some of our churches in our family of parishes. This weekend we will be closing the doors of Our Lady of Victory Oratory. This Frewsburg church has been joined together with St. James since 2008. After the final Mass on January 12, we will have an opportunity to share the wonderful family memories, clergy, Sacraments and celebrations shared in this holy place. We also take the call of our Holy Father, Pope Francis, in this Year of Hope to hold on to the hope that comes from Jesus Christ that He will lead us as a people of God. Let us keep all of our brothers and sisters, our neighbors in faith in prayer during this time of transition.

When I first came to the Jamestown area, I did not know that one of my most difficult responsibilities would be to see the closings of some of our beloved churches. But at the same time, I have found that my faith has been strengthened by our faithful parishioners who continue to place their hope and trust in our Lord Jesus through the hands of our Blessed Mother Mary. We ask that God will increase His Faith, Hope and Love deeply in our hearts and in our Family of Parishes.
