## Important Notice Regarding Raffles and Fundraising Activities

All parish organizations, ministries, and individual groups are reminded that **basket raffles and the sale of raffle tickets for fundraising purposes are regulated by New York State law.**

Under **New York State gaming regulations, no group may conduct a raffle or sell raffle tickets for a specific project or fundraiser without first obtaining a valid New York State Gaming License.** This requirement applies even when the raffle is intended to support a church-related ministry, program, or charitable purpose.

Conducting a raffle without the proper license is a **violation of NYS regulations** and may result in **fines or other penalties** if discovered.

### **Effective immediately:**

• Individual groups **may not independently run basket raffles or sell raffle tickets** unless a valid NYS Gaming License has been obtained and approved through the appropriate parish channels.

Any fundraising activity involving games of chance must be reviewed and approved **in advance** to ensure full legal compliance.

These regulations are in place to protect the parish, its ministries, and its volunteers. Your cooperation is essential to ensure that all fundraising efforts are conducted responsibly, and in accordance with state law.

If your group has questions or would like guidance on permitted fundraising activities, **please contact the Central Office and ask for Doris or Roseann.** We are happy to assist and help explore compliant fundraising alternatives.

## Support Needed for Upcoming Capital Projects at Sacred Heart

Sacred Heart Parish is asking for your prayerful consideration and support as we prepare for several important capital improvement projects that are essential to the care of our church.

Our **most urgent need is replacing the church roof.** The estimated cost for a new **metal roof is approximately \$142,000.** We are asking parishioners to consider **increasing their offertory donation** or making a **separate contribution to the Capital Improvement Fund** to help meet this significant expense.

The **next major project** will be the installation of a **new boiler.** With warmer weather approaching, we have a limited window before this becomes critical. Once estimates are received, we will share the projected cost with the parish.

The **third project** under consideration is a **side altar for the Pietà received from Our Lady of the Snows.** While funds donated for the Pietà project are already restricted for that purpose, it is not practical to proceed with this work until the roof issues are resolved.

For **auditing purposes,** any donation made toward these projects must **clearly state the intended use,** either on the check memo line or on an accompanying note.
